

Paul M. Varner Tuition Aid Fund

Rev. Paul M. Varner was a son of the Evangelical Lutheran Grace Church Congregation. A tuition aid fund was established in 1984 in celebration of his fiftieth year of ordination.

The following are guidelines for the tuition aid fund:

The Paul M. Varner Tuition Aid Fund is open to all members of Evangelical Lutheran Grace Church who are age 18-22 years old during their Freshman, Sophomore, Junior and Senior year at an accredited 2-year college, technical college or 4-year college and maintain at least a 2.5 GPA, regardless of major. There is no age restriction for a seminary student.

The amount of the tuition aid will depend on the amount in the fund. The maximum amount dispersed per year is \$350.00 per student. The maximum amount a student may receive will be \$500.00 for a 2 year college or technical degree or \$1000.00 for a 4-year college degree, and an additional \$750.00 for a seminary degree.

Application is to be received or postmarked by April 16th of each year. The governing body for this fund will be the Spiritual Growth Ministry Team.
